

Here are the main ways to travel from **Haneda Airport** to **Tokyo Station**:

✓ Cheapest → Keikyu Line + JR Train (¥500)


✓ Best for sightseeing → Tokyo Monorail + JR Train (¥660)

✓ No transfers & more comfort → Limousine Bus (¥1,000–¥1,300)

✓ Fastest & most convenient → Taxi (¥5,000–¥8,000)

1. By Train (Fast and Affordable)

 Travel Time: About 30–40 minutes

 Cost: ¥500–¥660

Option 1: Keikyu Line + JR Line (Cheapest Option)

1. Take the **Keikyu Airport Line** from **Haneda Airport Terminal 1/2 Station** to **Shinagawa Station** (about 15 minutes).
2. Transfer to the **JR Yamanote Line** or **JR Keihin-Tohoku Line** at **Shinagawa Station**, then ride to **Tokyo Station** (about 10 minutes).

 Total Cost: ¥500


Option 2: Tokyo Monorail + JR Line (Best for Sightseeing)

1. Take the **Tokyo Monorail** from **Haneda Airport Terminal 1/2 Station** to **Hamamatsucho Station** (about 13 minutes).
2. Transfer to the **JR Yamanote Line** or **JR Keihin-Tohoku Line** at **Hamamatsucho Station**, then ride to **Tokyo Station** (about 5 minutes).

 Total Cost: ¥660

2. By Limousine Bus (Best for Heavy Luggage)

 Travel Time: About 30–40 minutes (depends on traffic)


 Cost: ¥1,000–¥1,300


- Direct buses from Haneda Airport to **Tokyo Station (Yaesu or Marunouchi Exit)**
- No need to transfer, making it easier if you have a lot of luggage.

3. By Taxi (Fastest & Most Convenient)

 Travel Time: About 25–40 minutes (depends on traffic)

 Cost: Around ¥5,000–¥8,000 (extra charges for late-night rides)

- A **direct ride** from Haneda Airport to Tokyo Station.
 - Best for **groups** or if you need a **door-to-door service**.
